PLAN FOR SUCCESS ADDENDUM

1. ONLINE LEARNING

While our campuses remain closed, we are continuing to provide learning opportunities through Teams, a digital platform offered through district Microsoft accounts. A. Content Exposure

- i. Students are able to participate in activities to continue their learning online as long as the content being presented is related to standards the students have already covered during quarters 1-3.
- ii. Students are able to complete assignments in Teams to help raise their quarter 3 grades by replacing or adding points to existing items in the Synergy gradebook.
- iii. Students' grades cannot go down in any way from Quarter 3 due to failure to complete any assignment or activity provided during online learning.
- iv. Students are not to be assessed in any way during online learning (meaning tests, quizzes, etc are not to be given).

2. SEMESTER 2 GRADING PROCEEDURES

During our online learning, students will have assignments, projects, activities, etc available on Mondays each week. Each class will have scheduled opportunities to check-in virtually throughout the week and have access to additional content exposure. Unless otherwise noted, all assignments are due by Friday at noon with late work accepted for full credit by noon on **Friday May 1st**.

A. Creating Music Through Technology 1-2 (Periods 2 & 5)

- i. The Semester 2 Portfolio Grade has been changed from "not for grading" to "for grading" in Synergy as this is your only academic grade for the course.
- ii. The Semester 2 Portfolio grade has been cut in half (from 200points to 100points) for the ½ semester completed.
 1. *Our class actually completed almost 120 points worth of activities and projects during Quarter 3 so many grades are significantly boosted by the change in grade-book type.*
- iii. All graded activities that students complete during online learning will provide an opportunity for earned points to raise this Semester 2 Portfolio grade.

B. Falcon Music Technology 3-4 (Period 3)

- i. Students will have the opportunity to complete activities during online learning that will add additional letter grade standings to your “Achievement Level” grade.
 - 1. *Each completed activity with a score of x (TBD per assignment) will add 1 full letter grade to your score.*
 - 2. *Assignments and Activities can be resubmitted until the desired grade is achieved and the raised grade level is earned.*
 - 3. *Grades will be raised by no more than 1 letter per project/assignment/activity.*

C. Falcon Symphonic Band (Honors) & Marching Band 2 (Leadership Class)

- i. Students will be provided with a variety of continuing educational opportunities related to standards already covered during the school year.
- ii. Students are encouraged to participate in all enrichment and extended learning opportunities, especially as an honors course that is repeated each year for credit.
- iii. Students will also be given specific make-up assignments that will replace missing grades in the Synergy Grade Book and all make-up assignments will be specifically labeled with the corresponding grade they will replace.
 - 1. *All make-up work is due no later than noon on **Friday May 1st**.*

D. Senior Capstone Projects (Fine Arts Seal Students only)

- i. The Fine Arts Seal is still being awarded for this school year 2019-2020.
- ii. The due date for all items to be submitted has been pushed back to April 23rd for PXU students and a final acceptance date of April 26th with the state.
- iii. Students are to submit their new Capstone Reflections (writing assignments) no later than noon on **Friday April 3rd** by e-mail or Teams submission.
 - 1. *Students will have an opportunity to adjust any submissions if required and resubmit no later than **Friday April 10th at noon**.*
 - 2. *Students will also be required to complete the Teams assignment for Community Service Hour verification no later than noon on **Friday April 10th** so that all materials can be submitted for Arts Seal approval.*
